### TABLINGS

I, Hon. Member L J Lasindwa (ANC), tables the following Motion on the alignment of Provincial Budgetary allocations with Gauteng's Transformation, Modernisation and Re-industrialisation programme, in terms of Rule 121(1)(a), 121(2)(b) read with rule 117(1)(2)(d):

**Noting that the Economic Development Department:**

- (i) is the leading Department charged with the responsibility to radically transform, modernise and re-industrialise the economy of Gauteng to manifest decent work, broad-based economic inclusion and reduce inequality; and
- (ii) must therefore invest in economic infrastructure that stimulates the efficiency and productivity of the economy.

**Acknowledges that:**

- (i) the Department has made significant strides in supporting township enterprise in a manner that facilitates increased levels of economic participation and beneficiation for the township entrepreneurs and small scale industrialist;

- (ii) that this intervention includes the provision of training, funding, provision, provision of economic infrastructure as well as market access through Provincial Government procurement and partnership with private sector; and
- (iii) the Department is mainstreaming the participation of woman, youth and people with disability as well as the marginalised sector.

**Therefore calls on this house to debate:**

- (i) the extent to which the Budget of the GPG has since the inception of current administration, been able to create opportunities for Black entrepreneurs and industrialists in support of the Transformation, Modernisation and Re-industrialisation Programme (TMR).
